Sir/Madam,

With reference to your application dated 17.01.2007 and subsequent correspondence with the school/inspection in this regard, I am directed to convey the sanction for Provisional/Composite Provisional Affiliation for Secondary School Examination of the Board for a period of three years w.e.f. 1.4.2008 to 31.3.2011.

The above sanction is subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:

1. The school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT for the Middle Classes.
2. The school will follow syllabi and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Secondary School Examination and changes made therein from time to time.
3. The school shall appoint only qualified and eligible staff.
4. The school will help the Board in the smooth conduct of the examination by providing the necessary accommodations i.e. Rooms, Halls, etc. available in the school premises and furniture at its disposal for holding its examinations free of charges if required.
5. The school will spare sufficient teachers, for invigilation purpose at the examinations of the Board, as may be required.
6. The school will spare its teachers for evaluation of answer-books for the Board's examinations, if required.
7. The school will provide Laboratories, Library and other facilities as per norms of the Board.
8. The school will abide itself by the conditions of affiliation already prescribed by the State Government concerned.
9. Service agreement is executed with the staff as per norms generally accepted by the State Government concerned.
10. Service conditions pay and allowance and other benefits to the employees of the school shall be in no way less than that of corresponding employees working in Government Schools of the State in which the school is located. An undertaking to this effect be sent to C.B.S.E.
11. The school and its records shall be opened for inspection by an officer/official of the Board or an authorized representative of the Board/State Educational Department at any time and the school shall furnish information as may be asked for by the Board/State Government from time to time.
12. The rate of tuition fee and other fees charged should be commensurate with the facilities provided.
13. The admission to the school shall be opened to all without any discrimination on the ground of religion, cast or race, place of birth or any of them.
14. No unrecognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the same name of school.
15. The School will not sponsor candidates for Board's examination of any other School/Branch, which is not affiliated.
16. The school will create Reserve Fund as per the requirement of the Affiliation Bye Laws/Rules of the Directorate of Education, Delhi in the joint names.
17. The school should not start Class XI/XII without written approval of the Board. The Board shall not be responsible for any consequences in case class XI/XII is started without following the Affiliation Bye Laws and obtaining the prior approval of the Board.
18. The affiliation Code Number allotted to your school is 830189. This may please be noted and quoted for any correspondence with the Board.
19. Annual fee @ Rs.1500/- per annum for the year(s) three be also remitted at an early date. (In case of overseas Independent school @ Rs. 5000/- p.a. and overseas Kendriya Vidyalayas @ Rs. 3500/- p.a.)
20. The school will apply for further Extension of Provisional Affiliation on the prescribed form together with the prescribed fee and other essential documents in the preceding year before the expiry of the date.
21. Renewal of Registration of Society be ensured.

22. "The school will have to open CBSE pattern classes IX 2008-2009 session from which affiliation granted. Accordingly 1st Batch of class X of the school will be appearing at the CBSE Examination to be held in 2010 year.

Conditions for immediate compliance:

23. The school is required to submit an affidavit in original regarding non-proprietary character of the school/Society duly sworn in before a First Class Magistrate.

24. Other conditions are as per Annexure 'A' enclosed.

Other Conditions:

Conditions for which compliance to be submitted within three months of issue of sanction letter:-

1. Running starting of Class IX/X & XI/XII without prior Provisional Affiliation upto Secondary level/Sr. Secondary level from the Board would be unauthorised classes and school shall be responsible for the consequences arising out of it.
2. Non-submission of application for extension of provisional affiliation by 30th June of the year preceding to the year by which provisional affiliation granted, expires, would also attract violation of provisions of Affiliation Bye-laws.
3. School will not prepare any student/start any class for any other Board except CBSE from their CBSE affiliated school building/premises.
4. The Board would not allow any transfer of property/sale of school by one society/ Management/ Trust to another Society/Management/Trust through agreement/sale deed and the school shall not be closed down in the same premises. In case such transaction is effected explicitly or implicitly the Board shall withdraw its affiliation with immediate effect.
5. Pay & Allowances to staff should be revised time to time to bring it at par with that to State Government.
6. The service conditions be strictly followed as per State Education Act and Staff be given appointment/confirmation letters etc. accordingly.
7. 5-6 names of persons (atleast 2 from KVS/JNV) not below the rank of Principal of Sr. Secondary School affiliated with the Board be recommended so that two of them may be approved by the Board as its nominee in the School Managing Committee.
8. The school shall maintain section teacher ratio at least 1:1.5 at each level i.e. Primary (I-V) Secondary (VI-X) and Sr. Secondary (XI-XII).
9. The school has to constitute a committee for protection of woman from sexual harassment at the work place and to abide by the guidelines and norms prescribed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P. Criminal No.666-70 of 1992 Vishaskha and other State of Rajasthan and other delivered on 13.8.1997.
10. Rs. 3,000/- on account of annual fee for the 3 years may please be remitted.
11. The school shall maintain Reserve Fund in the joint names of the Manager of the school concerned and the Chairman of the Board in the scheduled Bank to the extent indicated below:-

Building Safety Certificate f. Certificate of Registration of Society/Trust/Company g. Safe Drinking Water and Sanitary Condition Certificate
6	The School shall also ensure the compliance with the Board’s Bye-laws in respect of following facilities and infrastructure within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS portal.
	1 Boundary Wall: Concrete boundary wall of not less than 6 ft. height, enclosing the school campus/site. Composite boundary walls which are partly concrete and partly grill/mesh/barbed wire below 6 feet will not be acceptable. If fencing/grill is required, then the same should be over and above 6 feet height.

	6 Well-developed Digital Infrastructure (Circular No. CBSE/AFF-10/2023 dated 24.03.2023)
7	The School is required to apply online for extension of affiliation in the preceding academic session before its expiry along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
8	The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
9	The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.

10	The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of Its website.
11	The School is directed to run at least 01 section each of bal-vatika I, II & III in accordance with established norms permitted vide Board's circular no. 12/2023 dated 24-03-2023 & 25/2023 dated 11-09-2023.
12	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with concerned COE.
13	The school is directed to ensure that all essential valid documents are available under the head Mandatory Public Disclosure (as per annexure– IX) on school's website at all time and the link of certificates should be remain functional.
14	As per the recommendation of NEP, the school shall ensure the participation of its students in the Structured Assessment for Analyzing Learning(SAFAL), an exam conducted by the Board every year. This exam, designed to assess and enhance students' learning, is a valuable initiative for their holistic development, as per the guidelines issued by the Board vide circular no: Acad-49/2024 dated 26 June 2024.
15	The school will ensure the Holistic Progress Card (HPC) is used for the foundational stage according to the guidelines issued by the Board via notification no. CBSE/Director (Acad.-Assessment)/2023 dated 27.12.2023.
16	The school shall submit an undertaking to upload all requisite information regarding students, teachers, and infrastructure details available in the school on the UDISE and OASIS Portals. The registration of the students in classes IX shall be conditional on the school providing complete information on the UDISE and OASIS Portals.
17	The school shall ensure that all teachers undergo at least 50 hours of Continuous Professional Development (CPD) every year, vide notification no. 16/2021 dated 24.09.2021, out of which 25 hours should be from concerned COE.
18	The school may make provision to establish rain water harvesting system in their school premises as per Board's circular no. CBSE/AFF./AC/RWH/2025 dated 24.03.2025.
Further, the school shall submit compliance on the following mentioned conditions within 03 months on the SARAS Portal from the date of the grant letter i.e. upto 30/08/2025. Failure to submit compliance within the stipulated time shall invite financial penalty of Rs. 50,000/- and appropriate action may be initiated as deemed fit.	
In case of partial acceptance of compliance, the school shall submit the remaining compliance's within further stipulated period of 03 months. In case of the failure of the school to submit the final compliance's, the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the school from filling up the Registration/LOC details of students of classes IX & X, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2027-28 .
